► MN Geospatial Commons

- The MN DNR Data Deli and MN Geographic Data Clearinghouse have both been retired and data have been moved to the Commons.
- Metadata Requirements are being established.
- MnGeo will be working with other groups to add their data.

► MN Parks and Trails Project

- Data integration and website project
- The goal is to help citizens look for parks and trails of regional significance.
- Legislatively mandated
- The University of Minnesota is conducting user surveys to assess use of recreation facilities, user needs and perceptions.
- DNR and MnGeo, in partnership with MetroGIS and others, aims to develop a recreation data standard, building on much previous work.

Statewide Geospatial Advisory Council

► Next Generation 9-1-1:

- MnGeo and Minnesota Department of Public Safety are coordinating
- Regional kickoff meetings have been held throughout the State
- A PSAP (Public Safety Answering Points) survey was distributed to assess the status of GIS data at PSAP's throughout the State
- An initial GIS Data Assessment is beginning.
- Minnesota NG9-1-1 GIS Standards are to be complete by October 2015
- A communication plan is being developed

► Parcels, Centerlines and Address Point Collection:

- Parcels, Centerlines and Address Points are critical for the NG9-1-1 project
- Working on data standards and collection methods
