- ❑ Collaboration between:
 - ❑ county Public Health Staff,
 - ❑ County and City GIS staff
 - ❑ County and City planning
- ❑ Web server hosted and maintained by Winona County since 2011
- ❑ Web Application developed by Houston Engineering

- ❑ Mobile Web applications use flash technology
 - ❑ Not supported in mobile platforms (android or IOS)
- ❑ ArcGIS 9.3 services technology (server and database)

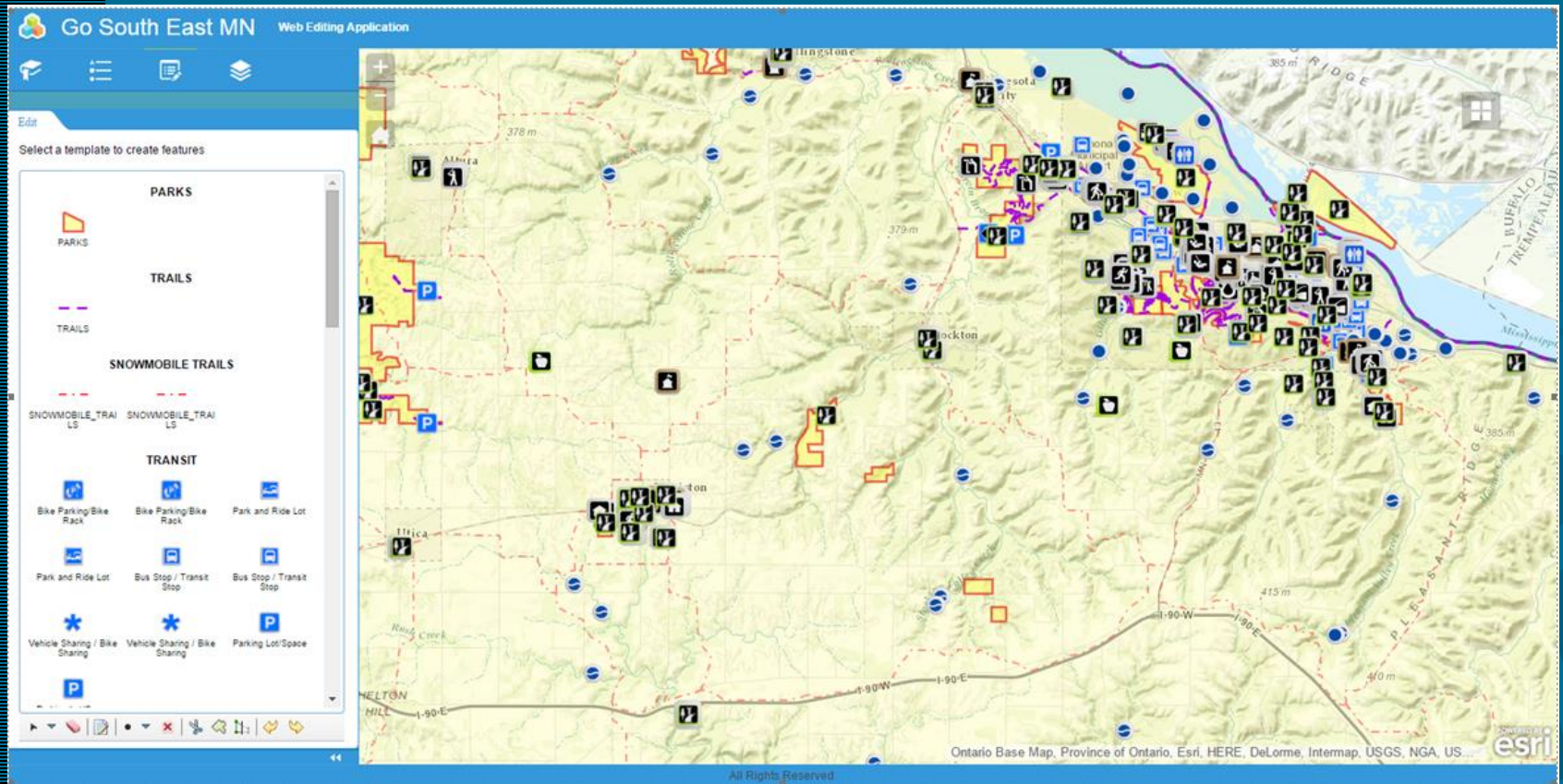

- ❑ Completed server virtualization
- ❑ Upgrades from ArcGIS 9.3 to 10.3.1
 - ❑ Server 10.3.1 complete
 - ❑ Geodatabase upgrade still pending
- ❑ Rebuilding web application REST services
 - ❑ Still pending
 - ❑ Will need to republish MXDs
- ❑ Web based feature editing utilizing customized AGOL app.
 - ❑ App ready. Need to re-establish REST endpoints to new server
