EM Challenges in Goodhue County

- Floods(seasonal and flash)
- High potential for Dam Breaches (3 low risk, 3 medium/high and 1 high risk structures)
- Rail Traffic
- Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant
- Recent change 300+ tourists twice a week(River Cruises)



How we work together

- Goodhue County EM is responsible for addressing within Goodhue County.
 - Work with GIS with the parcel viewer to measure and assign the address. GIS then drops the appropriate pins.
- Current layers that show EMS and Fire Service areas
- GIS maintains utility layers to keep us informed (Gas, Electric, pipelines)
- Bottom line EM would be lost without GIS and their resources!




Addressing

- Permitting provides rough information, we measure and plot the address(this is not exact, sometimes measuring isn't always correct)
- EM creates a basic map that provided that to 911, Assessors, and GIS. (GIS drops the points into the appropriate layer)
- Communication and Coordination is vital to this process(Hwy 52 Project-42 addresses to be reassigned, google)
- NG911-Application allows stakeholders to make changes/updates to NG911 in real time.

- ERG layer for quick evacuation mapping considerations
- Weather Integration
- Plume modeling for Radiological Emergency Preparedness event

 - WEA Survey Link








DART Team
