



Since March 2018 and the purchase of the Esri Small Government Enterprise License Agreement (SGELA), Olmsted County has been training over 500 staff (and counting) across all departments to use GIS and build creative Apps and StoryMaps in ArcGIS Online. To provide inspiration and a platform to ask questions, this presentation highlighted lessons learned and celebrated projects incorporating Esri's StoryMaps, Collections, WebApp Builder, Instant Apps, Experience Builder, Dashboards, Arcade, Survey123, and Hub. This included work by the following Olmsted County departments: Human Resources, Policy Analysis and Communications, Administration, Public Health, Community Services, Parks, Environmental Resources, Elections, Planning, Public Works, and of course Olmsted County's very own GIS Division.

Finally, there was a brief overview using Arcade to create an "on the fly" pop up chart from an "on the fly" related table.
