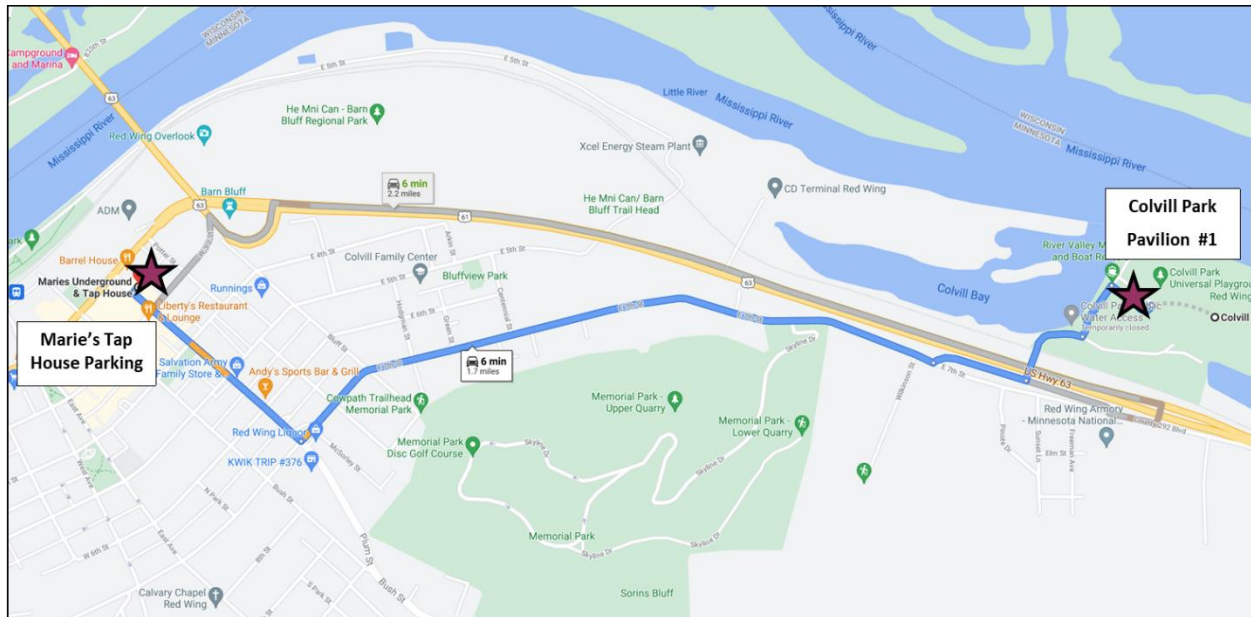

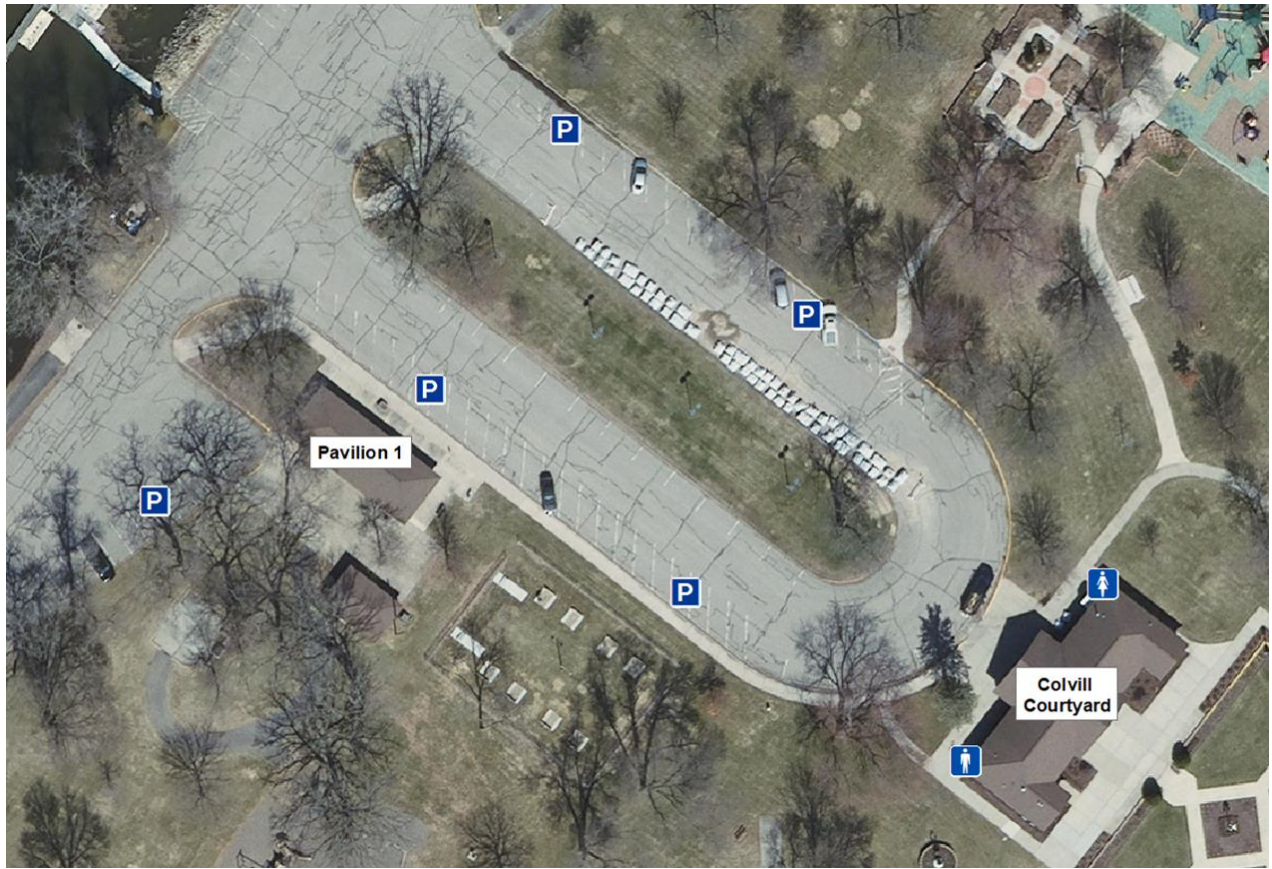
11:00 - Roundtable discussion on agency COVID strategies/other pandemic stories
