Hydrologic conditioning refers to the modification of a bare earth Digital Elevation Model (DEM) through an iterative GIS processing method to better represent the movement of surface water within a watershed. The purpose is to create a contiguous surface that accurately models flow across the landscape. These products are the basis for applications like the Agricultural Conservation Planning Framework (ACPF) or Prioritize, Target, and Measure Application (PTMApp) used to leverage geospatial data to inform watershed management.
